Block Party Conditions of Approval

Planning Dept.

1. The Temporary Use Permit Application and fee (\$50) must be submitted to the Planning Dept. no later than _____(date), by 4:00 p.m. Applications may not be accepted after this date.
2. The Applicant shall submit written permission from all residents within the event area including: the printed name, address and signature of each resident.
3. The Applicant, and each resident participating in the in the event, shall sign a “Hold Harmless Agreement” which will be submitted with the application.
4. The Applicant shall submit a site plan (map) of the designated event area delineating the street to be closed, identifying each residence on street to be closed, placement of cones/tubes and signage for road closure, and a minimum 12 feet wide lane kept clear for emergency vehicles.

Police Dept.

5. The Temporary Use Permit shall be enforced by Sheriff’s/Police Dept. and/or Fire Dept. Supervisor or his/her designee.
6. Only cones/tubes shall be used for street closure.
7. Sign(s) must be posted for street closure.
8. The applicant is responsible for all participants attending the event.
9. The Temporary Use Permit and Conditions of Approval shall be posted in a highly visible location and available for inspection upon the request for Public Safety personnel.
10. Emergency public safety vehicles shall have a clear and unobstructed 12 feet wide access lane to all residences within the designated event area.

11. The applicant shall cooperate with any requests by a Sheriff's/Police Dept. Supervisor, his/her designee to cease and terminate the event at any time it is deemed in the best interest of public safety.
12. The Sheriff's/Police Dept. has the authority to shut down the event for any violations of the "Conditions or Approval" or any concerns they deem as a safety problem.
13. Alcohol shall not be permitted to be sold.
14. Alcohol shall only be consumed within the designated event area.
15. No one under 21 years of age is permitted to consume alcohol, per Fillmore Municipal Code Chapter 15.65; underage drinking is a public nuisance, and a citation will be issued to the applicant.
16. The applicant shall take full responsibility for all intoxicated people and their actions.
17. The event shall end by 11:00 p.m. and the Applicant is required to remove all materials and debris from street and sidewalks and open the street.

Fire Dept.

18. No illegal fireworks per Fillmore Municipal Code Section 15.39.010: The person(s) using; allowing; providing illegal or legal fireworks in a dangerous manner are subject to a \$1000 fine.
19. Any evidence of use of illegal fireworks within the permitted area will result in the revocation of this permit, and the roadway must be opened immediately.
20. Emergency public safety vehicles shall have clear and unobstructed access to all residences within the designated event area.
21. The Fire Chief or his designee has the authority to shut down the event for any violations of the "Conditions of Approval" or any concerns they deem as a safety problem.
22. The Applicant shall cooperate with any requests by the Fire Chief or his designee to cease and terminate the event at any time it is deemed in the best interest of public safety.
23. Block Parties will not be issued for major arterials; e.g., .A, B, C, D, Mountain View St., Sespe, River.
24. Future Block Party applications will be denied to applicants who do not follow the above stated Conditions of Approval.
