NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Sections 22552, 22553, and 22626 of the Streets and Highway Code of the State of California and Section 6061 of the Government Code of the State of California, that a Public Hearing will be held before the City Council of the City of Fillmore on Tuesday, May 12, 2020, at 6:30 P.M, to **CONSIDER THE ADOPTION OF RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S ANNUAL LEVY REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/21 AND ORDERING THE ANNUAL LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF FILLMORE LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 2 AND HERITAGE VALLEY LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING DISTRICT 2007-1 FOR FY 2020/21.**

Summary: A Public Hearing will be held to consider whether to approve the annual budget report and setting the levy amounts for FY 2020-21 for Fillmore Landscape and Lighting District No. 2 and Heritage Valley Landscape and Lighting District 2007-1 pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, as amended, and codified in Part 2 of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code of California (commencing with Section 22500). The resolutions would approve the Engineer's Report for FY 2020-21, order the levy and collection of annual assessments with the City Fillmore Landscape and Lighting District No. 2 and Heritage Valley Landscape and Lighting District 2007-1. A copy of the Engineer's Annual Levy Report is available on the City of Fillmore Website (<https://www.fillmoreca.com/>) and in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Fillmore. The levy amounts are to be set on the formula approved by the voters. This levy is collected by the County Assessor's Office with property taxes for all parcels within the assessment districts.

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 issued on March 17, 2020 in response to the present State of Emergency due to the threat of COVID-19, the City Council is conducting this public meeting via teleconferencing and will make this meeting accessible electronically to all members of the public seeking to observe and to address the City Council, and all requirements in the Brown Act requiring the physical presence of Council Members, the Clerk, City personnel, or the public as a condition of participation in or quorum for a public meeting are waived. Any person with an interest in this item may make public comments, under the public comment portion of the agenda or on any agenda item, pursuant to the City Manager's [Temporary eComment Policy](#). In accordance with this policy please submit your eComment to the Deputy City Clerk via email at eherrera@fillmoreca.gov. The comment period for each regular meeting agenda will begin at 4:30 p.m. the Friday before the Tuesday meeting. The comment period will close once the applicable section of the agenda has been completed at that meeting. If you wish to legally challenge any action taken by the City on the above matter, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City prior to or at the public hearing. (Cal. Government Code Section 65009.) Further information on this matter can
