Mr Mayor and members of Fillmore City Council, my name is Joey Juhasz-Lukomski and I am a Fillmore resident and the executive director of BikeVentura, a countywide bike advocacy nonprofit.

I urge you to allocate TDA funds to projects that make biking and walking safer and more enjoyable in Fillmore. The pandemic and subsequent stay safe at home order have only magnified the value and popularity of biking and walking in communities. There are more families riding the bike path or walking the streets to get exercise than ever before. Gyms and parks are closed, transit is scary, and people are spending more time with their kids outside.

Kids are learning online with no time for PE courses. Kids need to be active to learn. The comment period for each regular meeting agenda will begin at 4:30 p.m., the Friday before the Tuesday meeting. The comment period will close once the applicable section of the agenda has been completed at that meeting. The eComments will be distributed to the City Council and will not be read out loud during the "Public Comment" time of the Council meeting or at the applicable item for an item on the agenda, eComment users should not expect responses to their comments made under "Public Comment" time.

Personal information volunteered by the user in their eComment is treated as a public record and may be subject to public inspection and copying if not protected by federal or state law.

The following are provided to inform you of the City meeting decorum:

In the "Public Comments" portion of the meeting, members of the public may address the legislative body regarding any matter which is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the legislative body and not already listed on the agenda.

Under state law, the legislative body may not take action on matters not described and listed on the agenda. However, subjects raised may be referred to staff or placed on the agenda of a subsequent meeting.

The members of the legislative body and audience must preserve order and decorum, and must not delay or interrupt the proceedings, disturb the peace of the meeting, interrupt another speaker, or refuse to obey the order of the council or the presiding officer.

During City council meetings, there is a three minute (3 min) time limit for each speaker. The Mayor/Chair or a majority of City Council/Legislative body may extend or shorten time limits.

Power presentations are not allowed during public comment due to time constraints.

Mayor Holmgren and City Council Members,

As a Fillmore resident raising two young children here, I am deeply troubled by yet another incidence of police profiling in our community. This incident that occurred less than a week ago involved youth who live in this community, one of whom is just 13 years old, being targeted by officers who told them that they "look like gang members". The officers proceeded to intimidate these children in an effort to make them believe that they should give their names to these officers, as the officers took photos of their faces. In a subsequent conversation between Sergeant Duffner and a parent of one of these children, there was a complete lack of concern over any of this. The sergeant argued that stopping these children specifically (and only) because they looked and dressed a certain way, was not profiling.

This is the type of policing that erodes trust in a community. It's the type of interaction that makes me believe that as the parent of a brown skinned child, I cannot and should not expect that my child won't be seen as a criminal before he's seen as worthy of protection.

I hope that this is the type of issue that the Community Committee will address directly. I hope that this concerns the City Council as much as it concerns me and that you will do what you can to make sure that the Sheriff knows that they have work to do in their department and their community.
